Please join in any of the fun events of our week. It only happens once a year—but when it's here it brings fun to all!



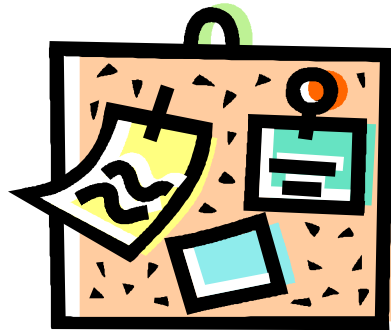

**KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS ESSAY CONTEST**

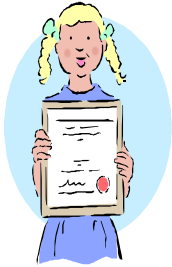
Students in grades five through eight are writing on the topic: **What Qualities Do You Consider the Most Important in a Friend?** I would encourage all parents/

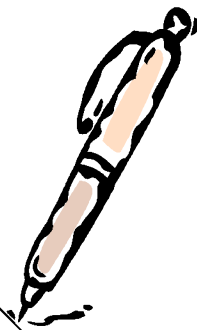
