Count on Academics and Innovation!

Students experience a comprehensive academic program including special teachers for art, physical education, music, library, computer instruction, and Spanish for all grades. We have an Accelerated Reading Program incorporating online testing and rewards. An enrichment program is available for grades 4 through 8. A resource teacher works with students who require extra academic assistance.

We use a full range of technology to stimulate learning and help students use all types of tools, particularly in the Computer Learning Lab. To bring an interactive curriculum learning material to every classroom, Smart Boards are in use. Also, technology directly based on the curriculum at each grade level is used in classrooms and for home assignments.
